### PERFORMANCE AGREEMENT

#### The Contracting Parties

Geingob, on the one part, and the Ministry of International Relations and Cooperation, (hereinafter referred to as MIRCO or the Ministry), represented by the Minister, Hon. Netumbo Nandi-Ndaitwah, on the other part. This Performance Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "PA") is entered into between the Government of the Republic of Namibia (hereinafter referred to as GRN),

#### PREAMBLE

WHEREAS The People of Namibia overwhelmingly and willingly gave the Government the mandate to consolidate past gains and to pursue the lofty ideals set out in Vision

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

### Part I: Undertaking by the First Party

## Part II: Undertaking by the Second Party

In consideration of the Government's undertakings and assurances, THE SECOND PARTY, the Minister agrees to:

- (a) Provide the leadership needed to enhance Namibia's image abroad and to promote and protect national interest
- (b) Direct implementation of Foreign Policy and the strategic activities of Namibia's diplomatic Missions and Consulates
- (c) Provide leadership in mainstreaming Harambee Prosperity Plan in the Foreign Policy Implementation
- (d) Strengthen inter-ministerial coordination and collaboration in the area of international relations and cooperation
- (e) Provide conducive environment for efficient performance and entrench high performance culture in the Ministry
- Strengthen bilateral and multilateral relations and cooperation, taking into account Namibia's national interest.

- (g) Give political support and facilitation to the implementation of the PA by the Deputy Ministers, and ED
  (h) Oversee the development and implementation of citizens' service charters in all key departments and outlets that interface with the public;
  (i) Ensure that the resources availed to the Ministry by both Government and other sources are efficiently utilized for the benefit of our people

- (k) Perform duties assigned by the President diligently and as per the oath taken when appointed to the Ministerial position by His Excellency, President Hage G.

- Strengthen inter-ministerial coordination and collaboration in the area of international relations and cooperation;
- Promote a conducive environment for efficient performance and inculcate a culture of excellence in the Ministry,

- Strengthen bilateral and multilateral cooperation;
- Review of foreign policy

#### Part IV

### Reporting lines and requirements:

- . The ED will be required to submit quarterly performance progress reports to the Minister
- Hon. Prime Minister. Minister will submit Quarterly Progress reports on performance of the ministry for submission to, and discussion with, H.E. the President, through the Rt.
- **₹** The Minister undertakes to give feedback to the Deputy Minister and ED on the quarterly performance report
- the end of the year. The Minister further undertakes to provide leadership to ensure that annual performance report is prepared and submitted to the President a month after
- < H.E. the President commits to personally preside over the performance evaluation sessions of ministries within two (2) months after the end of the tinancial year.
