- Gross national electricity generation capacity increased

- Minister will submit Quarterly Progress reports on performance of the ministry for submission to, and discussion with, H.E. the President, through the Rt. Hon. Prime Minister,
- The Minister undertakes to give feedback to the Deputy Minister and ED on the quarterly performance report;
- The Minister further undertakes to provide leadership to ensure that annual performance report is prepared and submitted to the President a month after the end of the financial year;
