Invitation to serve as Board Members for Namibia Civil Aviation Authority

The Namibia Civil Aviation Authority (NCAA) is a statutory organization established by the **Civil Aviation Act No. 6 of 2016** ("the Act") to ensure safety and security of civil aviation in Namibia and, under the auspices of the Minister of Works and Transport (MWT), to administer Namibia's treaty obligations in accordance with the Chicago Convention, among others, and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

In compliance with section 8 of the Public Enterprises Governance Act of 2019 as well as in accordance with section 12 of the Namibia Civil Aviation Authority Act of 2016 competent and qualifying individuals are invited to apply for consideration for appointment as Board Members of Namibia Civil Aviation Authority.

Minimum Requirements: An appropriate Masters-Degree at NQF Level 9 (or an equivalent qualification) either in Aviation, Transport Management, Financial Management, Human Resource Management/Strategic Management or Law.

Additional Requirements

- A minimum ten (10) years' working experience of which five (5) year should be at a Senior Managerial or Executive Level in the relevant field.
- Previous Board experience in a Public Enterprises as well as business experience and or business acumen would be an added advantage.
- Must be a Namibian citizen.
- Must have no criminal record;
- Applicant must not be currently a member of 2 Boards of Public Enterprises
