#### **Invitation to serve as Board Member Transportation Commission**

The Transportation Commission of Namibia is a statutory body established in terms of section 3(1) of the Road Traffic and Transport Act (RTTA), 1999 (Act No. 22 of 1999) as amended.

The Ministry of Works and Transport invites suitably qualified individuals to submit applications to be appointed as members of the Transportation Commission of Namibia.

**Minimum Requirements:** An appropriate B-Degree at NQF Level 7 (or an equivalent qualification) in either Economics/Finance/Transport and Logistics/Law/Public Administration, plus ten (10) years appropriate experience.

#### **Additional Requirements:**

Possession of a Master's degree in any of the above fields will be an added advantage.

- For legal practitioners, applicants must be enrolled as Legal Practitioners under the Legal Practitioners Act, 1995 (Act No. 15 of 1995) and who have practiced as such for a period of at least five years, also persons who have experience in, and shown ability in connection with transportation, industrial, commercial and/or financial matters or in the conduct of public affairs.
- Must be a Namibian citizen.
- Must have no criminal record;
- Applicant must not be currently a member of 2 Boards of Public Enterprises
