SECTION I: INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. Rights of Public Entity

The Ministry of Information Communication and Technology reserves the right:

- (a) To split the award of the contract as per the lowest evaluated cost per item, or
- (b) To accept or reject any quotation; and
- (c) To cancel the quotation process and reject all quotations at any time prior to contract award.

2. Preparation of Quotations

You are requested to quote for the services mentioned in Section III by completing, signing and returning:

- (a) The Quotation Letter in Section II with its annex for Bid Securing Declaration.
- (b) The Priced Activity Schedule in Section IV;
- (c) The Specifications and Performance Standards Compliance Sheet in Section V; and;
- (d) Any other attachment as deemed appropriate.

You are advised to carefully read the complete Request for Quotations document, including the Special Conditions of Contract in Section VII, before preparing your quotation. The standard forms in this document may be retyped for completion but the Bidder is responsible for their accurate reproduction.

3. Validity of Quotations

The quotation validity period shall be 90 days from the date of bid submission deadline.

4. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible to participate in this Quotation exercise, you should:

- (a) Have a certified copy of Founding Statement/valid Company Registration Certificate
- (b) Have an original/certified copy of a valid Good Standing Tax Certificate;
- (c) Have an original/certified copy of a valid Good Standing Social Security Certificate;

7. Sealing and Marking of Quotations

Quotations should be sealed in a single envelope, clearly marked with the Procurement Reference Number, addressed to the Public Entity with the Bidder's name and contact information at the back of the envelope.

8. Submission of Quotations

Quotations should be deposited in the Quotation/Bid Box located at *The Ministry of Information and Communication Technology - Trust Building*, 2nd Floor, not later than 17 November 2025 at 10H00. Quotations by hand delivered should reach *The Ministry of Information and Communication Technology -Trust Building*, 2nd Floor by the same date and time at latest. Late quotations will be rejected.

Quotations received by e-mail will not be considered.

9. Opening of Quotations

Quotations will be opened internally by the Public Entity immediately after the closing time referred to in section 8 above. A record of the Quotation Opening stating the name of the Bidders and the amount, the presence or absence of a Bid Security/Bid-Securing Declaration will be put on the website of the Public Entity and available to any bidder on request within three working days of the Opening.

10. Evaluation of Quotations

Bids compliant to the Conditions of Bid shall be evaluated in hand with the below listed criteria. Each category shall be evaluated and awarded according to proof submitted.

Evaluation will be conducted by a Bid Evaluation Committee (BEC) appointed in accordance with the Procurement Act and Regulations will evaluated in accordance with the criteria stated here below and in tables 1, 2 and 3 in stages.

NB: Only bids submitted before closing deadline shall be evaluated

1. STAGE 1: EVALUATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND LEGAL COMPLIANCE (MANDATORY COMPLIANCE)

The administrative and legal compliance will be assessed based on a Yes or No basis. 14. Prices and Currency of Payment

Prices for the execution of services shall be fixed in Namibian Dollars as quoted. Quotations shall cover all costs of labour, materials, equipment, overheads, profits and all associated costs for performing the services, and shall include all duties. The whole cost of performing the services shall be included in the items stated, and the cost of any incidental services shall be deemed to be included in the prices quoted.

15. Award of Contract

The Bidder having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive quotation and qualified to perform the services shall be selected for award of contract. Award of contract shall be by issue of a Purchase Order/Letter of Acceptance in accordance with terms and conditions contained in Section VI: Contract and General Conditions of Contract
