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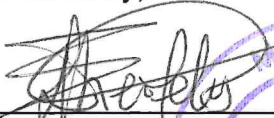

1. BRIEFING ON THE OPERATIONALISATION OF THE PUBLIC PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP (PPP) ACT, 2017 (ACT NO. 4 OF 2017)

Cabinet took note of the development of the Public Private Partnership (PPP) Act, 2017 (Act No. 4 of 2017) regime in Namibia to leverage private sector expertise, innovation, financial resources to support inclusive economic growth, through enhanced infrastructure development and improve public service delivery.

Cabinet further directed all Offices/Ministries/Agencies currently having projects in the PPP Project Register to engage the PPP Unit to ensure finalisation of outstanding matters and to fast track the project implementation process.

2. OUTCOME OF THE ANNUAL MEETINGS OF WORLD BANK GROUP (WBG) AND INTERNATIONAL MONETARY FUND (IMF)

Cabinet took note of the outcome of the 2025 Annual Meetings of the Board of Governors of the World Bank and the International Monetary Fund (IMF).

Furthermore, Cabinet took note of Namibia's involvement in Energy Compact and the need for Namibia to take advantage of the upcoming Africa Investment Forum, in Morocco on 25 November 2025, where energy compacts will be presented for in-depth analysis.

Cabinet also supported the National Planning Commission and Ministry of Finance's engagement with both the World Bank and IMF in the area of budget digitalisation with emphasis on the use of local expertise.

Additionally, Cabinet supported the preparation of Namibia's Investment Plan under the oversight of the National Planning Commission to ensure grant funding for green industrialisation.

3. TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCH (TAC) FOR ROCK LOBSTER FOR THE 2025/2026 FISHING SEASON, 1ST NOVEMBER 2025 TO 30TH MAY 2026

Cabinet took note of the stock and economic status of Rock Lobster sub-sector and endorsed that the Total Allowable Catch of Rock Lobster be set at one-hundred and eighty (180) Metric Tonnes (MT) for the 2025/2026 fishing season effective from 1st November 2025 to 30 May 2026.

4. TOTAL ALLOWABLE CATCH (TAC) FOR HAKE FOR THE 2025/2026 FISHING SEASON, 1ST NOVEMBER 2025 TO 30TH SEPTEMBER 2026

Cabinet took note of the state of the Hake stock assessment and endorsed the Hake Total Allowable Catch (TAC) to be set at one hundred and thirty-three thousand (133,000) Metric Tonnes (MT) for the 2025/2026 fishing season, with effect from 1st November 2025 to 30th September 2026.

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
